**WASHINGTON COUNTY LAW STUDENTS AWARDED MILTON D. ROSENBERG SCHOLARSHIPS**

WASHINGTON—County residents Jonathan R. McCloskey and Shane M. Rumbaugh are the 2012 winners of Milton D. Rosenberg Scholarships funded in part by the Rosenberg family and members of the Pennsylvania Association for Justice (PAJ). The scholarship is named for the late and revered Milton D. Rosenberg, distinguished Washington County trial lawyer, past president, and a founder of PAJ.

In announcing McCloskey and Rumbaugh as scholarship winners, PAJ President Kenneth M.
