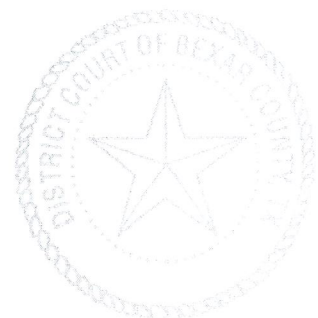

SPECIAL ORDER
REGARDING THE WEARING OF FACE COVERINGS WHILE IN COURT

The CDC continues to study the spread and effects of the novel coronavirus across the United States. Studies have shown that a significant portion of individuals with coronavirus who can transmit the virus to others are asymptomatic. This means that the virus can spread between people interacting in close proximity even if those people are not exhibiting symptoms. The CDC recommends that people wear face coverings in public settings where other social distancing measures are difficult to maintain.

For this reason, it is HEREBY ORDERED that all persons must wear face coverings when entering any courtroom in the justice center complex, which includes the Bexar County Courthouse, the Cadena-Reeves Justice Center, the Paul Elizondo Tower, and all court chambers and all court offices. This measure is taken in an effort to reduce the spread of the coronavirus. This order will continue in effect until May 8th, 2020.

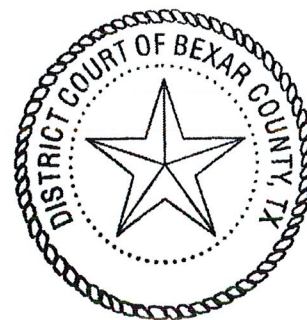
