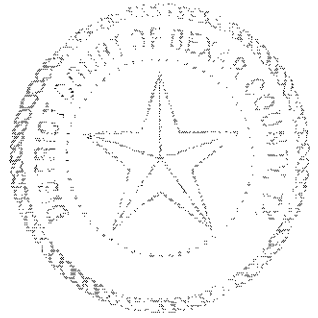

**SPECIAL ORDER TO ATTORNEYS PRACTICING IN THE
CRIMINAL DISTRICT COURTS OF BEXAR COUNTY
DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC**

In an effort to continue adhering to local and federal social distancing guidelines and to reduce the number of individuals coming to the courthouse, effective immediately all attorneys practicing in the criminal district courts of Bexar County:

- 1) Will be required to file any and all motions electronically using the e-filing system (<https://reviewer.efiletexas.gov/>). Only essential matters will be heard in person pursuant to the Court of Criminal Appeals Order (No. 20-008). If you have an essential matter that needs the court's attention, you should contact the court coordinator to have the matter referred to the presiding court or jail court. No motions will be considered unless they are e-filed and urged to the court for consideration. You can urge the court to review a motion by notifying the coordinator of the filing.
- 2) Will be allowed to file attorney vouchers without the requirement of a notary signature. The vouchers can be emailed directly to the court coordinator of the court. The following are the email addresses for the district court coordinators:

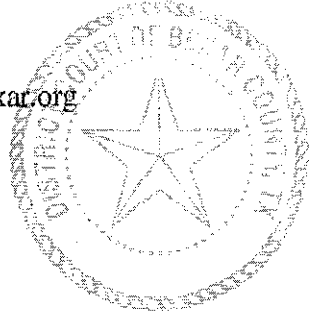

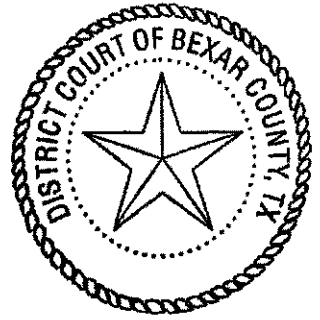
