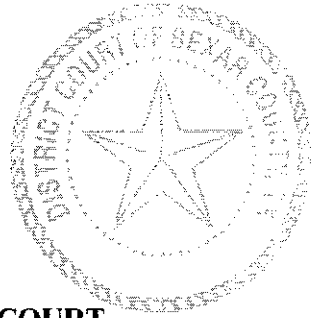

**SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER RELATING TO CRIMINAL DISTRICT COURT
OPERATIONS DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC**

On April 17, 2020, the Office of Court Administration issued Updated COVID-19 Guidance #7, recommending that all in-person proceedings of any size be delayed until at least June 1st. The recommendation is based on the Supreme Court of Texas (No. 20-9044) and The Court of Criminal Appeals (No. 20-008) Third Emergency Order Regarding the COVID-19 State of Disaster, "prohibiting non-essential proceedings in person contrary to local, state, or national directives..." In order to comply with the order and the recommendations of the Office of Court Administration this Court extends the following presiding schedule as follows:

The suspension of all regularly scheduled dockets in all criminal district courts is hereby extended through Friday, May 29, 2020.

No non-essential proceedings should be held in-person.

Where it is not possible or feasible to hold an essential proceeding remotely, all such essential proceedings in all criminal district courts in Bexar County shall be referred to the coordinator of the Presiding Court for placement on the in-person docket of the presiding criminal district court for the week. If an essential proceeding must be held in-person, the presiding court should ensure that no more than ten persons are gathered in the courtroom or in areas around the courtroom, all persons in the courtroom and courtroom area must wear face coverings, and social distancing in the courtroom must be observed.

Only proceedings deemed by the presiding criminal district court judge to be essential will be heard in-person.

Preference will be given to those essential proceedings that may result in the release of an inmate from the Bexar County Adult Detention Center.

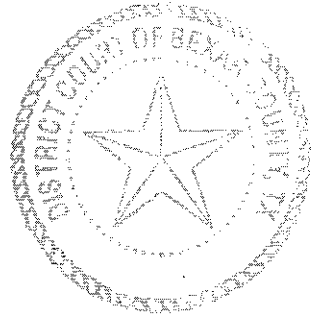

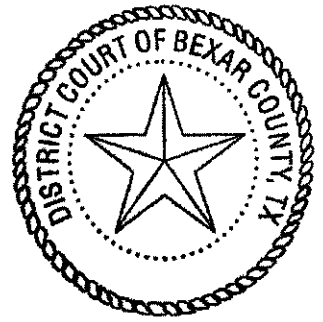
