SDCBA Public Statement Regarding Transgender Military Service Members

SAN DIEGO, July 28, 2017 – San Diego is a proud military town with one of the highest concentrations of service personnel in the country at over 100,000 individuals. President Donald Trump recently commented via Twitter that transgender troops would not be allowed to serve in any capacity in the armed forces. Whether his statement has or will become the policy of the United States military is still unclear.
