Brittany Rogers (Chair) received her undergraduate degree from the University of California Los Angeles in 2008, graduating on the Dean's Honor List with a double major in political science and history. During her college years, her internship at a consumer law firm led to a full-time position upon graduation and solidified her desire to make a career of advocating for individuals. She went on to receive her J.D. from the University of California, Hastings College of the Law in 2012. While in law school, she was a member of the Hastings Race and Poverty Law Journal and led multiple student organizations focused on giving back to the community. She interned at Public Counsel, the largest pro-bono law firm in the country, tackling the issues of homelessness in the Los Angeles area. She also devoted time to the Legal Aid Foundation of Los Angeles and worked to increase public access to free and low-cost legal services. In 2011, Brittany began as a law clerk at the Law Office of Scott Righthand, P.C. and was hired as an associate upon passing the bar in 2012. In addition to representing Plaintiffs in litigation, Brittany continues her commitment to public service as a mentor to high school students in the San Francisco Bay Area and working on campaigns for promoting politically progressive issues and candidates

Anna Dubrovsky has been representing injured plaintiffs for 20 years and is a well-known, respected personal injury attorney. She has an excellent record of securing favorable settlements and verdicts, and she understands the specific needs of those suffering from personal injuries caused by negligence. She began her career defending and representing insurance companies. During that time, she decided that she would rather be an advocate for the victims. Having this specialized knowledge of how the insurance industry works, however, has made Ms. Dubrovsky highly effective at litigating personal injury cases. Ms. Dubrovsky has been successful at obtaining numerous multi-million dollar settlements and verdicts and was able to win one of the largest verdicts on record in San Mateo County. In 2009, she was nominated for Trial Lawyer of the Year by both the Consumer Attorneys of California and The San Francisco Trial Lawyers Association. She was also named as a 2010 finalist for the coveted "Street Fighter of the Year Award" and Trial Lawyer of the Year Award by the Consumer Attorneys of California. Ms. Dubrovsky was also nominated as a finalist for the "2011 Trial Lawyer of the Year Award" by the San Francisco Trial Lawyers organization.

Audrey Siegel received her Juris Doctor from Boston University School of Law, where she graduated cum laude, and in the top 25% of her class. Audrey has focused on personal injury and wrongful death litigation including premises liability, inadequate security, automobile accidents, and product liability since she began practicing law in 2012. She also has experience in employment discrimination, landlord/tenant law, and medical malpractice litigation. In addition to being a member in good standing with the California Bar Association, Audrey is active with the San Francisco Trial Lawyers Association (SFTLA), Consumer Attorneys of California (CAOC), American Association for Justice (AAJ), and the San Francisco Bar Association (BSF). She presently serves as the Event Vice-Chair for the Executive Committee of the Barristers' Litigation Section of BASF. In addition, she is on the SFTLA Diversity Committee and Continuing Legal Education Committee and will join the SFTLA Board of Directors in the upcoming year. Audrey received recognition as a Finalist for San Francisco Trial Lawyer of the Year in 2016 for her work on a trip and fall case. Audrey was also a recipient of the Bar Association of San Francisco's Outstanding Volunteer in Public Service Award in 2014 for her work representing tenants.

Sandra Ribera Speed started Ribera Law Firm in 2011. Since the firm's inception, Ms. Ribera Speed has had the honor and privilege of representing Katherine Jackson, the mother of Michael Jackson, in a variety of matters. In 2012, she joined the blockbuster legal team headed by the renowned personal injury firm, Panish, Shea, and Boyle, to represent Mrs. Jackson and Michael Jackson's children in the wrongful death action against concert promoter AEG Live. Which, ultimately AEG Live was found responsible for hiring the doctor that was convicted of causing Michael Jackson's death. Ms. Ribera Speed has also been asked to co-counsel with the renowned San Francisco-based civil rights and employment law firm, the Law Offices of Mayor Joseph L. Alioto and Angela Alioto.
