Atraumatic Flapless Removal of Erupted Teeth and Broken Roots | Subject Code 310

When difficult, erupted teeth are removed, the standard protocol taught in most dental school is to reflect a flap and remove bone. This not only results in more bleeding, swelling, and pain, but also can severely compromise the chances for good esthetic and functional implant reconstruction. This course will **review techniques that enable predictable and rapid removal without the need for flaps or bone removal from out socket walls. In addition, simplified and predictable socket grafting procedures will be reviewed.**

- Understand negative sequelae from reflecting flaps and removing labial plate
- Learn the instrumentation necessary for the flapless procedure
- Learn how to safely use a Mallet to empower the Proximator to do its work
