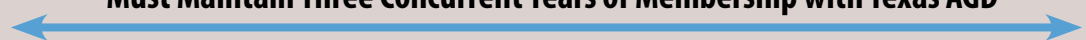
↳ Of the 1,100 CE hours, at least 400 hours of CE must be from participation courses in specific disciplines.
