

Everything you need to know about CLE's Oklahoma Mandatory Continuing Legal Education

Please note that the Bar Center building is closed and undergoing a remodel. There will not be an option to come in and watch recorded CLE's at our building. All CLE's (live and recorded) are virtual.

We know some people prefer to binge watch CLE's. This year you can either watch them for free when they're broadcast live, or you can download recorded CLE's for a discounted fee from the VocalMeet platform. Please note that the VocalMeet platform tracks participation and will stop every 20 minutes to ask a question which must be answered to be able to complete the video.

We've received several questions from members asking if we can look up the status of their CLE credits for the year. We are not able to look up that information, but below are the steps you can take to track your progress.

How to Track the Status of your OKMCLE Credits

To look up how many CLE credits you have completed and that are submitted to your account, visit www.okmcle.org. We are not able to look up this information for an attorney. Here are the directions sent to us from our contact at the OBA:

First step - click on the link below the Attorney Login spot that reads, "Don't have an account yet? Sign up." Even if they think they might have previously created an account here and they don't remember the password, this link still works and it works better than the Lost Password process.





Second step – on the next screen, enter the bar number and date of birth

To create your free MyOKMCLE account, please complete two simple steps. Registration is easy and provides you with instant access to your OK MCLE Transcript, compliant assurance services and other online features.



Third step – on the next screen, confirm or change and confirm the email address and create a password. They can even use a password they might have used before, as long as it meets the password rule requirements.



Important Update:

Effective January 1, 2021, the annual ethics requirement will increase to 2 OK MCLE approved ethics credits per year. The total required credit will remain 12 credits. For more information, check out the MCLE Rules under the Resources tab above. See Rule 7, Regulation 3.6.
