Are you worried about going to prison?
Are you looking for help? We offer a free screening program that can help you find an alternative to incarceration and/or treatment options.

HOW SCREENING WORKS

- » Screening is **FREE** and completely voluntary for those facing charges in Tulsa County
- » Screening takes 20-45 minutes and can be completed over the phone or face to face
- » The screening can help identify if you are eligible for a specialty court or program instead of prison.
- » Recommendations will be made about what program is best if you are at risk of going to prison.
- » You will not be asked about the facts of your case, and screening information cannot be used against you.
- » You may be eligible or benefit from mental health or substance abuse treatment, special programs for veterans, employment assistance and housing support.
