The 2019 Law Day theme focuses on these cornerstones of representative government and calls on us to understand and protect these rights to ensure, as the U.S. Constitution intends, "the blessings of liberty for ourselves and our posterity."

TULSA COUNTY STUDENTS WHO ENTER THE OBA CONTEST AUTOMATICALLY ENTER THE TULSA COUNTY BAR FOUNDATION CONTEST.

- To enter both contests, your entry to the Oklahoma Bar Assn. (OBA) must be received by Friday, January 11, 2019, mail to OBA Law Day Committee, P.O. Box 53036, Oklahoma City, OK 73152.

(After the OBA contest is over, all Tulsa County entries will be sent to the Tulsa County Bar Center for its contest.)

- To separately enter the Tulsa County Bar Foundation contest, entry must be received by Friday, April 12, 2019, mail or deliver to the Tulsa County Bar Center, 1446 South Boston Avenue, Tulsa, OK 74119.
- Students from all Tulsa County schools (pre-K to 12th grade) are eligible.
- Please attach the Entry Form on the back of the student's entry. (Entry form attached on page 3.)
- In the Tulsa County Bar contests, students can enter (and potentially win) both the Writing and Art contests for their grade level (there are no second place prizes). If a Tulsa County student is an OBA contest winner, they are not eligible for the same contest in the Tulsa County Bar Foundation competition. The Tulsa County Bar Foundation contest is limited to Tulsa County students unless no other Tulsa County entries are received.
- Prizes are different and independent for each bar association contest.
- In February 2019 OBA contest winning entries will be published in the Oklahoma Bar Journal and posted to the OBA website at www.okbar.org/lawdaycontest - for any questions check the website.
- Target date to announce Tulsa County Bar Foundation contest winners: by April 26, 2019.

- Prizes: \$35.00 to winner for each grade level.
- Coloring sheets will be available on Law Day link at www.tulsabar.com
- Judging based on quality and artistic presentation
- Entries will not be returned.

Art Contests (1st Grade through 12th Grade)

- Prizes for each grade level: 1st grade and 2nd grade \$35.00; 3rd grade and 4th grade \$50.00; 5th grade through 8th grade \$60.00; 9th grade through 12th grade \$100.00
- Examples of entries might be used to document student community service project (digital or DVD format preferred), a video production, mixed media artwork, original music, creative writing, poetry, photography, collage and anything else that relates to the contest theme
