TULSA COUNTY DISTRICT COURT DOCKET FOR MISDEMEANOR CASES THAT WERE SUSPENDED DUE TO COVID-19 INFECTIONS IN TULSA COUNTY AND SURROUNDING AREAS.

Tulsa, Oklahoma January 25, 2021 Tulsa County District Court is announcing a misdemeanor disposition docket due to the suspension of misdemeanor cases as a result of COVID-19 infections in Tulsa County and surrounding areas. Highlights of the docket are:

1. The Tulsa County District Court, with the assistance of the Tulsa County District Attorney's office, the Tulsa County Public Defender's Office, the Tulsa County Court Clerk's office and the Tulsa County Sheriff's Office will be conducting a special criminal misdemeanor disposition docket at the Cox Convention Center ("Cox docket") on January 29, 2021. Representatives from each office will be present during the docket.
2. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the number of matters that were continued on the Court's dockets, roughly 400 criminal misdemeanor cases have been identified for possible disposition. Tulsa County Court Services, the Tulsa County Public Defender's Office and local bondsman have made significant efforts to contact these Defendants in an effort to resolve the pending cases and remove a significant backlog from the misdemeanor docket.
3. Those defendants who have been contacted shall appear on January 29, 2021, and enter through the east door of the Cox Convention Center on the street level.
4. There will be no more than 2 people per 8 foot table, and no more than 10 persons per row socially distanced 6 feet apart. Everyone will be required to wear a mask; if a person does not have a mask, one will be provided. Access to the courtroom will be limited to attorneys, parties, and necessary staff. Deputies and bailiffs will be on site to enforce these protocols.

5. This docket will not apply to misdemeanor domestic violence cases.
6. Arrival times for the docket are as follows:

Defendants with the last name A-C will be at 9 a.m.

Defendants with the last name D-I will be at 10:30 a.m.

Defendants with the last name J-Q will be at 1:30 p.m.

Defendants with the last name R-Z will be at 3 p.m.

The docket is available on OSCN.

- 7. Only defendants called to this docket may appear. Family members and other persons arriving with a defendant will not be permitted to enter the building.**

8. Tulsa County District Court is committed to following all appropriate CDC, state and local health department rules and guidelines.
