

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS - VIRTUAL ANNUAL CONVENTION

Q. If it is a “pay-what-you-can” fee, why did you put a suggested fee?

We want every person to be able to attend our annual convention; however, we know that due to the COVID-19 pandemic people's finances have been hit hard. The Texas Court Reporters Association Board of Directors has implemented a pay-what-you-can fee to ensure everyone is able to attend. The suggested fee is meant to give our members guidance on what to pay if they are able.

Q. How do I put the amount I can afford?

On the registration form, there is a blank to put your amount. Simply put the amount that you will be paying to attend the virtual convention. You can do this through the printable registration form or online registration.

Q. What if I want to pay more?

Thank you!!! Simply put the amount you want to pay in that blank and include it in your payment to TCRA with your registration form.

Q. I already registered. Can I get a refund if I don't want to attend virtually or a partial refund if I paid the in-person registration fee?

Q. My county pays for my registration fee for Convention. What amount do they pay?

The pay-what-you-can feature is intended for CSR members financially affected by COVID-19, so the fee that the county would pay would be the \$150. If your county has already paid the full registration fee and requires a refund of the difference, please provide Brooke Ingram the information of how the check should be made out and the address the refund should be sent.

Q. I have already registered at the \$345 rate. Can I use the balance of the difference to have a colleague attend at no cost to them?
