**RE:** 2014 Mock Trial Exhibit Stipulations

---

The following stipulations were released for use at the 2014 district competitions. The purpose of this Memorandum is to clarify that **these stipulations are to be considered a part of the case materials for the 2014 state competition.** They remain unchanged from those released for use at district competitions.

---

Agreed Stipulation No. 5 of the 2014 Mock Trial State Competition case materials is amended as follows:

5. All exhibits included with these materials, including the audio recordings of the two musical works at issue in this case, are authentic. No objections to the authenticity of the exhibits may be made. Participants are reminded that Rule 3 of the Competition binds each witness “by the facts in his/her own witness statement, the statement of facts, if any, and any necessary documentation or exhibit pertinent to his/her own testimony.” Exhibits may still be objectionable under the Mock Trial Rules of Evidence or require a proper foundation for admission. The following stipulations apply to various exhibits:

- a. Both Dr. Doe Raymie and Dr. Jan Cristin Dagmar Bøud can testify that the printed lyrics to each song are correct and accurate transcriptions;
- b. Likewise, each expert witnesses can testify that both lead sheets are accurate representations of the musical works at issue;
- c. Dr. Doe Raymie prepared and has knowledge of his curriculum vitae;
- d. Dr. Jan Cristin Dagmar Bøud prepared and has knowledge of his curriculum vitae;
- e. Jordan Evergreen has knowledge of the citation issued by the Weston County, Tennessee Sheriff's Department;

- f. Stonie Tarck has knowledge of the certified copy of conviction from the Shrader, Tennessee Circuit Court; and
- g. Both Jessie Jameson and Tommie Ghee have knowledge of the Friendbook exchange. Jessie Jameson can testify that he/she knew the person associated with the Friendbook profile "Tommie Ghee" to be, in fact, Tommie Ghee. Likewise, Tommie Ghee can testify that he/she knew the person associated with the profile "Jammin' Jessie Jameson" to be the plaintiff in this case.
