Discharge Diagnoses

Foreign Body Ingestion (1" galvanized screw)

Hospital Course

Patient arrived at ER complaining of foreign body ingestion of metal after eating a chicken sandwich. ER performed CT of chest and abdominal region. Foreign body identified in lower left quadrant.

Successfully performed endoscopic foreign body removal and retrieved a one-inch (1") galvanized metal screw from PT's abdomen, lower left quadrant. PT tolerated procedure well. Subsequent to endoscopic foreign body removal, performed EGD to check for tears in lining of esophagus and abdomen. Noted no damage to PT's teeth or mouth, as also noted per Dr. Jefferson intake. PT's esophageal lining and interior walls of the stomach and duodenum appeared unremarkable. The PT tolerated the procedure well and without apparent complications. The PT does not appear to have any of the expected consequences of unintentionally ingesting such a large foreign metal object.
