Forty-eight dollars (\$48) of your dues is for a one-year subscription to the Tennessee Bar Journal. For federal income tax purposes, TBA dues (regular and section dues) may be deductible as a business expense but are not deductible as a charitable contribution. The TBA estimates that fifteen percent (15%) of dues are allocable to nondeductible lobbying expense. Therefore, eighty five percent (85%) of dues are deductible to the full extent provided by law. LAWPAC contributions are not deductible as either a charitable contribution or a business expense.

“Income” is law-related salary, wages or income after deducting office overhead and other ordinary and necessary business expenses but before taxes, FICA, insurance and pension contributions for the current year.

**SENIOR COUNSELOR** — The TBA Senior Counselor Membership is \$50 for TBA member attorneys with a minimum of five years continuous membership who will have practiced 50 years or who will reach age 75 by July 1, 2022. Senior Counselors can become Patron Members for \$125.
