

Chief Disciplinary Counsel Board of Professional Responsibility

The Supreme Court of Tennessee and the Board of Professional Responsibility are seeking a highly motivated and qualified individual to fill the position of Chief Disciplinary Counsel. The Chief Disciplinary Counsel employs and supervises the staff needed to assure compliance with the requirements promulgated in Tenn. Sup Ct. R. 8, R. 9, and related Rules applicable to enforcement of the ethical regulations of the legal profession in Tennessee.

Applicants must be licensed attorneys in Tennessee and have a thorough knowledge of general law, state laws, established precedents, attorney disciplinary system, Rules of Professional Conduct, and recent ethics opinions. Experience in administration, management, and supervision is preferred. Applicants should have excellent communication skills, both written and oral.

After the initial screening of resume's and writing samples, those selected for interviews will have their names submitted to the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation for a thorough background investigation and an individual report will be generated to identify any history of prior discipline with the Board of Professional Responsibility.

Interviews for this position will be held on November 2, 2012. Applicants invited to interview will be contacted after October 12, 2012, for a specific interview time and location.
