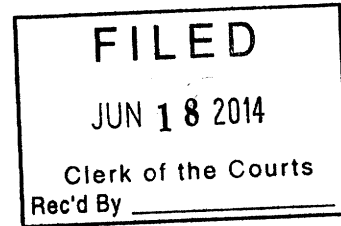

**ORDER OF SUMMARY SUSPENSION FOR
