The Toledo Bar Association Pro Bono Legal Services Program

Pro Bono is a program operated through the Toledo Bar Association in which private attorneys volunteer to provide legal services and assistance with certain legal problems.

To qualify for Pro Bono help you **must**:

- **be a resident of Lucas County** and;
- **be income eligible** according to guidelines set by the Legal Services Corporation.

There is no cost.

Cases that Pro Bono may accept:

- Family Law
- Minor Probate, Guardianships, and Relief of Administration
- Bankruptcy
- Defense of Lawsuits
- Expungements
- Incorporations of Non-profit Programs

Pro Se “Do-It-Yourself” Clinics:

- Divorce—assists clients with *pro se* divorce filing and paperwork. Separate clinics for clients with or without children of the marriage.
- Expungement—assistance in filing for an expungement. Lawyers help fill out forms and answer questions.
- Juvenile Court Issues—for a variety of forms used in Court.
