

**Jack Leifer • San Antonio**

Dr. Leifer is currently an Associate Professor in the Department of Engineering Science at Trinity University, and has been on Trinity's faculty since August 2005. He has been licensed as a Professional Engineer in the Commonwealth of Kentucky since June, 2002, and in the State of Texas since September, 2006. He obtained his undergraduate degree in Mechanical Engineering from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology in 1987, and his MS and PhD degrees were obtained in Mechanical Engineering from the University of Texas at Austin, in 1989 and 1995 respectively. He worked as an Assistant Professor of Mechanical Engineering at the University of South Carolina – Aiken, from 1994 – 2000, and held a similar position in the University of Kentucky Engineering Program at Paducah from 2000 – 2005. In addition, Dr. Leifer worked in the area of Computational Structural Mechanics at the NASA Langley Research Center in Hampton, VA, for a total of six months (over three years), as a multi-year recipient of a NASA Summer Faculty Fellowship. He has authored or co-authored over 14 peer-reviewed research publications in the areas of engineering mechanics, crash analysis and measurement, and has been consulted as an expert witness in crash reconstruction for over 10 years, with over 450 retained engagements to date.
