The law office of Attorney Dean Boyd is based in Amarillo, Texas with twenty folks in the operation. Over the last 25 years, Dean's work concentrated exclusively on injury matters such as motor vehicle wrecks, nonsubscriber workplace injury claims and wrongful death cases. He has multi-million dollar results in cases he's personally handled. Dean was previously certified as national Class Action counsel in a successful case involving 16,000 insurance agents and he's pretty sure he and Channy Wood hold the record for the largest pain and suffering jury verdict ever in the Texas panhandle (\$1.7 million verdict against IHOP for a group of Salmonella victims in 2011). After attending Abilene Christian University, Dean was an insurance adjuster before he headed off to SMU School of Law. He's licensed in both Texas and Oklahoma.

A TTLA Fellowship member, Dean has been a longtime supporter of TTLA serving on the Board of Directors, Listserve Committee, Legislative team, Membership Committee, Eight Day Chair, CLE Speaker, PAC contributor, etc. He is known for being down to earth and easy to work with. Some from the listserve old days may remember him as Mr. "Prove it" or "Make Me". For some reason, his colleagues feel it necessary to constantly tell him that he takes a lot of "weird" cases.

Dean also works with panhandle civic organizations such as Family Support Services and Big Brothers Big Sisters of the Texas Panhandle. He is a member of TTLA, The Oklahoma Association for Justice and the American Association for Justice.
