Editorial Policy Manuscript Guidelines

Thank you for your interest in submitting an article for publication in the Virginia Trial Lawyers Association's *Journal*. *The Journal* is published quarterly and is sent to every member of VTLA and the judiciary in Virginia.

Our articles generally focus on practical legal information written in an entertaining and educational manner. *The Journal* is not a law review publication. Articles tend to be of immediate value to VTLA members by giving them timely information and practice tips.

Articles published in *The Journal* deal with topics in the following broad subject areas: products liability, medical-legal issues, criminal law, domestic relations, general torts, workers' compensation, and trial/practice advocacy.

Every article submitted to *The Journal* is considered by the VTLA Publications Committee, which meets quarterly, to accept, deny and/or edit submissions.

Editorial Policy

The Publications Committee of Virginia Trial Lawyers Association (VTLA) reserves the right to accept, deny and/or edit articles and article headlines submitted for publication in *The Journal* for substance, clarity and/or space considerations. Authors are granted the right to review edited articles upon request, however, the Committee retains final approval regarding the article's publication.

Copyright

All articles published in *The Journal* are copyrighted by and shall remain the property of VTLA. Articles may be copied or reprinted only with the permission and at the sole discretion of VTLA.

Manuscript Guidelines

Length: Generally, articles typically run around 10 double-spaced, typed pages (or an approximate word count of 2,000-4,000), although some subject areas obviously require more and some may require less.

Footnotes: Where footnotes are necessary, please place the citations and notes on a separate page and not within the body of the text. Endnotes should be kept to a minimum. Legal references should follow the Uniform System of Citation (Blue Book).

Form: Please submit your article via email, preferably in Word format.

Biographical Information/Photo: Please submit with your article, a black/white photograph (passport size is fine) and a brief biographical sketch.

Compensation: No compensation is offered for any article in *The Journal*.

Previously Published Articles: Exceptional articles printed in other forums will be considered.
