A passionate advocate for equity, Councilwoman Lisa Clancy's path to the St. Louis County Council follows a lifetime of service to others. Born and raised in Webster Groves, Lisa left St. Louis after college graduation and relocated to post-Katrina New Orleans, where she served as a Teach for America Corps Member. In her special education classroom, Lisa saw firsthand how her low-income students and their families deserved strong advocates both in their classroom and in their communities. In the ensuing decade, Lisa has worked in the nonprofit sector, focusing on work that breaks through the status quo in order to improve the lives of children, families, and communities in most need. She brings the priority to the County Council where she was elected to a 4-year term to represent District 5 in November 2018. Lisa is active in several nonprofit organizations including NARAL Pro-Choice Missouri and We Stories. She lives with her 3 year-old son and her husband in Maplewood.
