- **Communion Is A Celebration.**

- a) The Lamb (Sacrifice)
- b) The Bread (Matzah)
- c) The Cup (Cup of Redemption)
- d) The Dessert (Afikomen)

1. Look back — we remember.

"...Look! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!" John 1:29 (p.809)

"...This is my body, which is given for you. Do this to remember me." Luke 22:19 (p.805)

"This cup is the new covenant between God and his people—an agreement confirmed with my blood..." Luke 22:20 (p.805)

2. Look around — we proclaim.

"For every time you eat this bread and drink this cup, you are announcing the Lord's death until he comes again." 1 Corinthians 11:26 (p.877)

"And they have defeated him by the blood of the Lamb and by their testimony." Revelation 12:11 (p.956)

3. Look ahead — we anticipate.

"Mark my words—I will not drink wine again until the day I drink it new with you in my Father's Kingdom." Matthew 26:29 (p.757)
