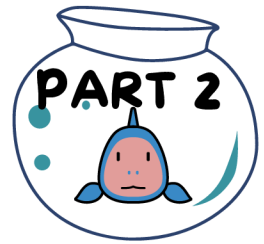
Questions:

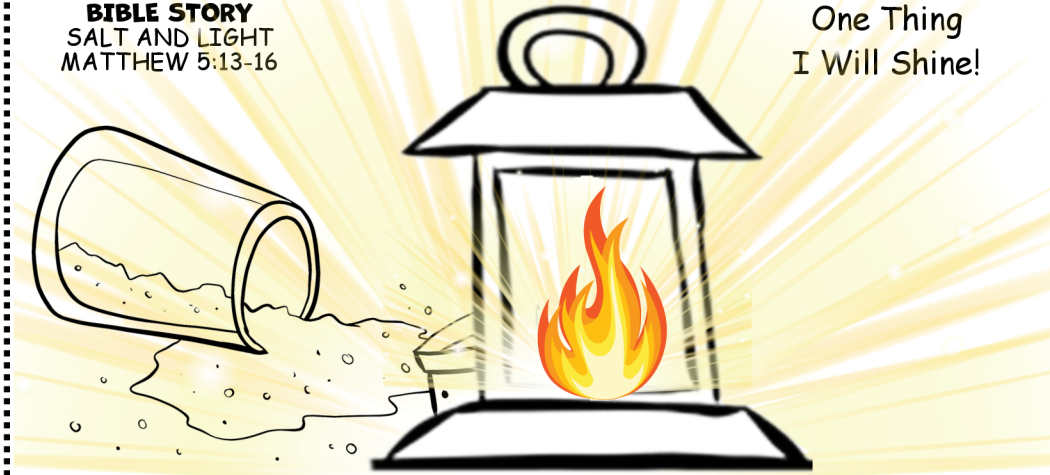

underfoot as worthless.



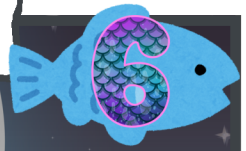
"You are the light of the

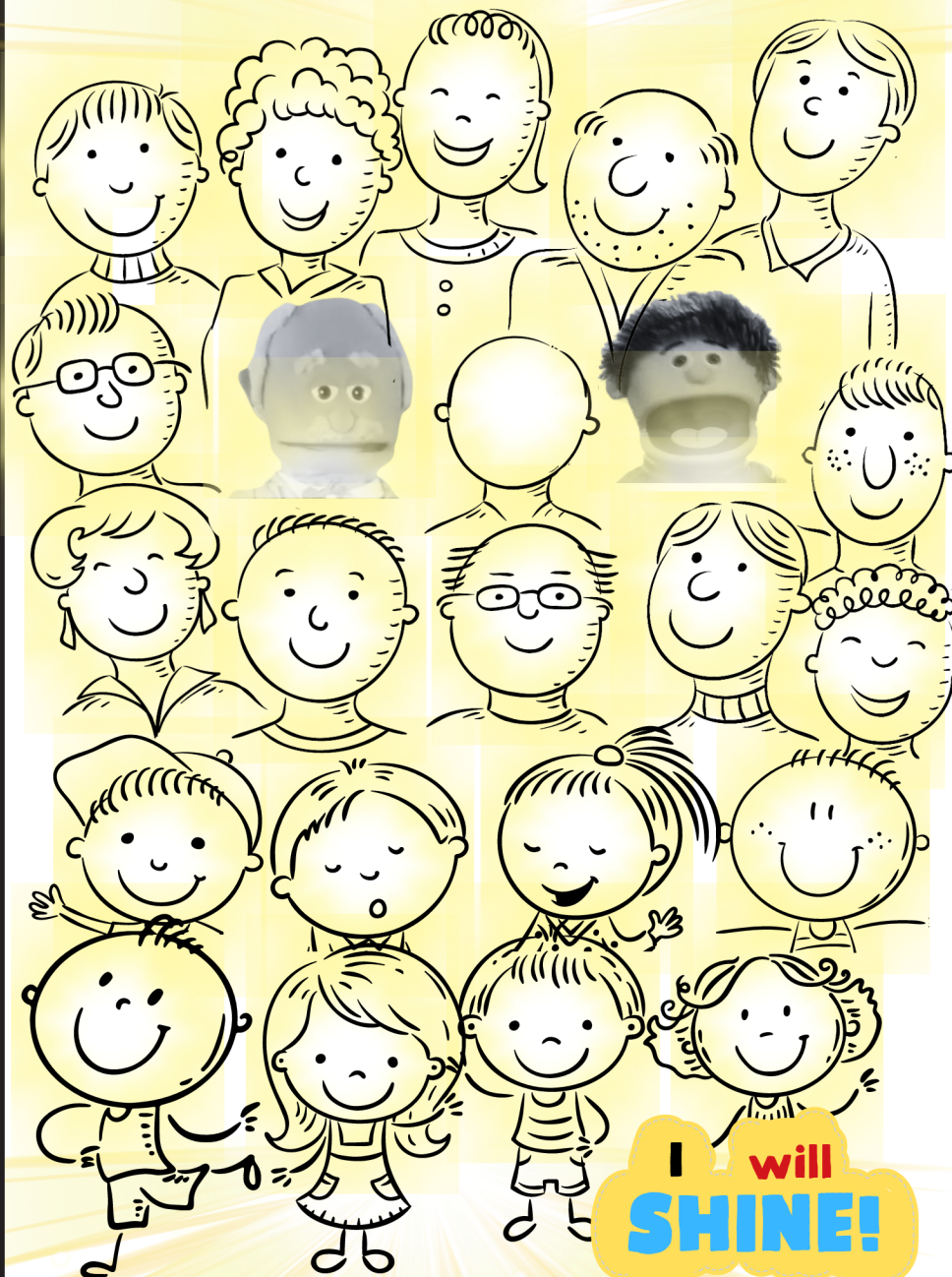

Make your face in-between them.



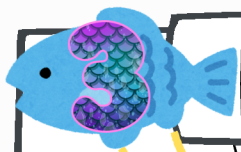
