READ AND BAKE TOGETHER

Noah sat at the kitchen table, feeling quite confused after hearing that God is three in one. "Mom, how can God be three but also one?" he asked. His mom smiled and reached for the cookie dough. "Let me show you," she said. Mom used food coloring and made three colored balls of dough- blue, red, and yellow. "Blue is like God the Father, Who made everything. This red dough is like God the Son, Jesus, Who became our Savior. And yellow is like God the Holy Spirit, Who comforts us." Mom had Noah press the three colored dough balls together, forming one cookie. "See? Three parts, but now they're one." As the cookie baked, Noah watched, fascinated. When it was done, he held the single cookie in his hands. "It's one cookie, but it's still made of three parts!" he exclaimed. His mom nodded. "It's not a perfect explanation, but it helps us understand a little bit better the mystery of God's Trinity."

Bake Your Own Trinity Cookie

• Pillsbury Ready to Bake Sugar Cookie Dough
• Red, Yellow, and Blue food coloring
Make three 1-inch balls of dough, working food coloring into each as you knead and roll into balls. You will need 1 yellow for God the Holy Spirit, 1 red for God the Son, and 1 blue for God the Father. Place the 3 balls close together on a pan and squish the 3 together using the bottom of a cup or a rolling pin. Bake at 350 for 10-12 minutes or until the bottom is browned. Eat and enjoy, reviewing that God is 3 in one!



Read The Baptism of Jesus


Matthew 3:13-17



"Then Jesus went from Galilee to the Jordan River to be baptized by John.




But John tried to talk him out of it. 'I am the one who needs to be baptized by you,' he said, 'so why are you coming to me?'
