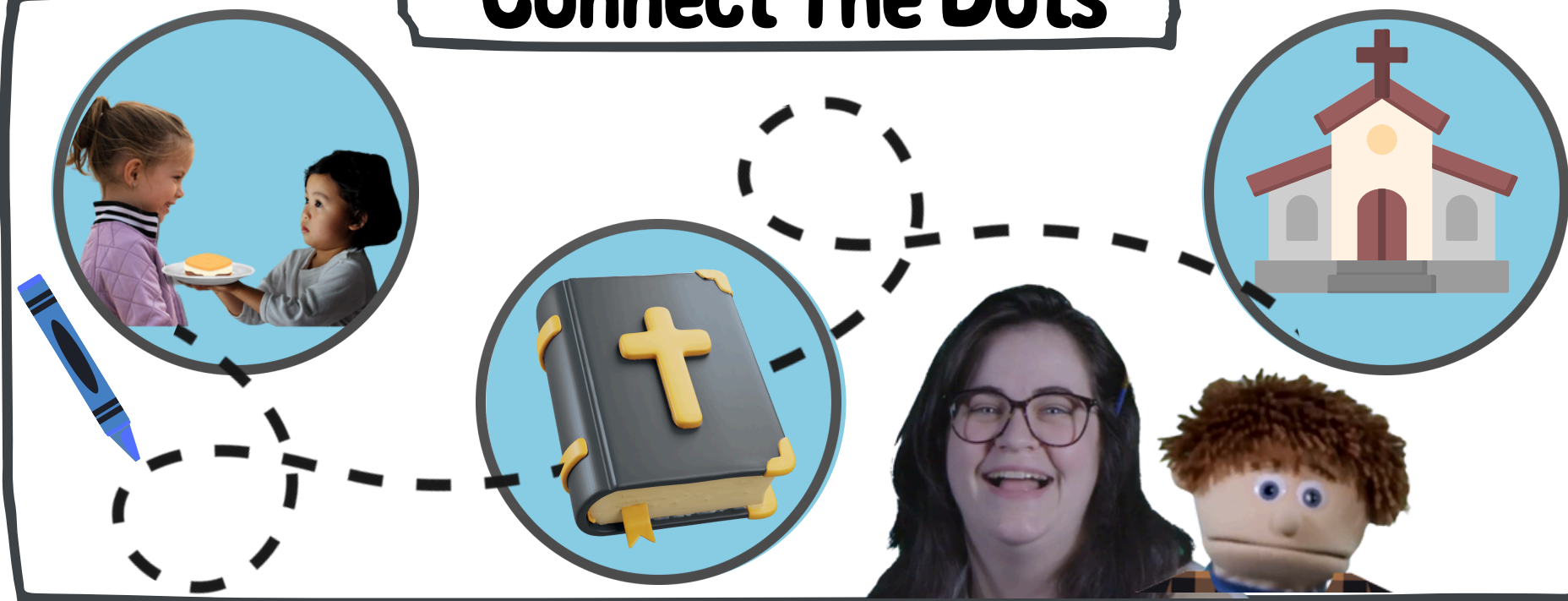


# Connect The Dots
