



Annie Remembers Jesus

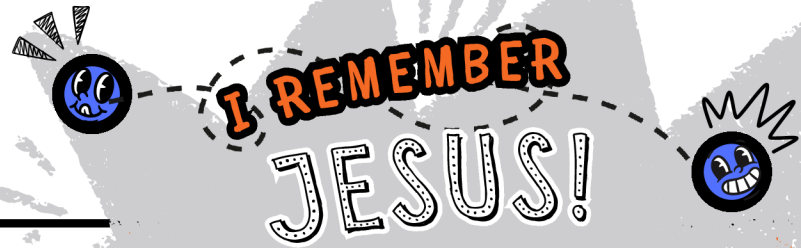

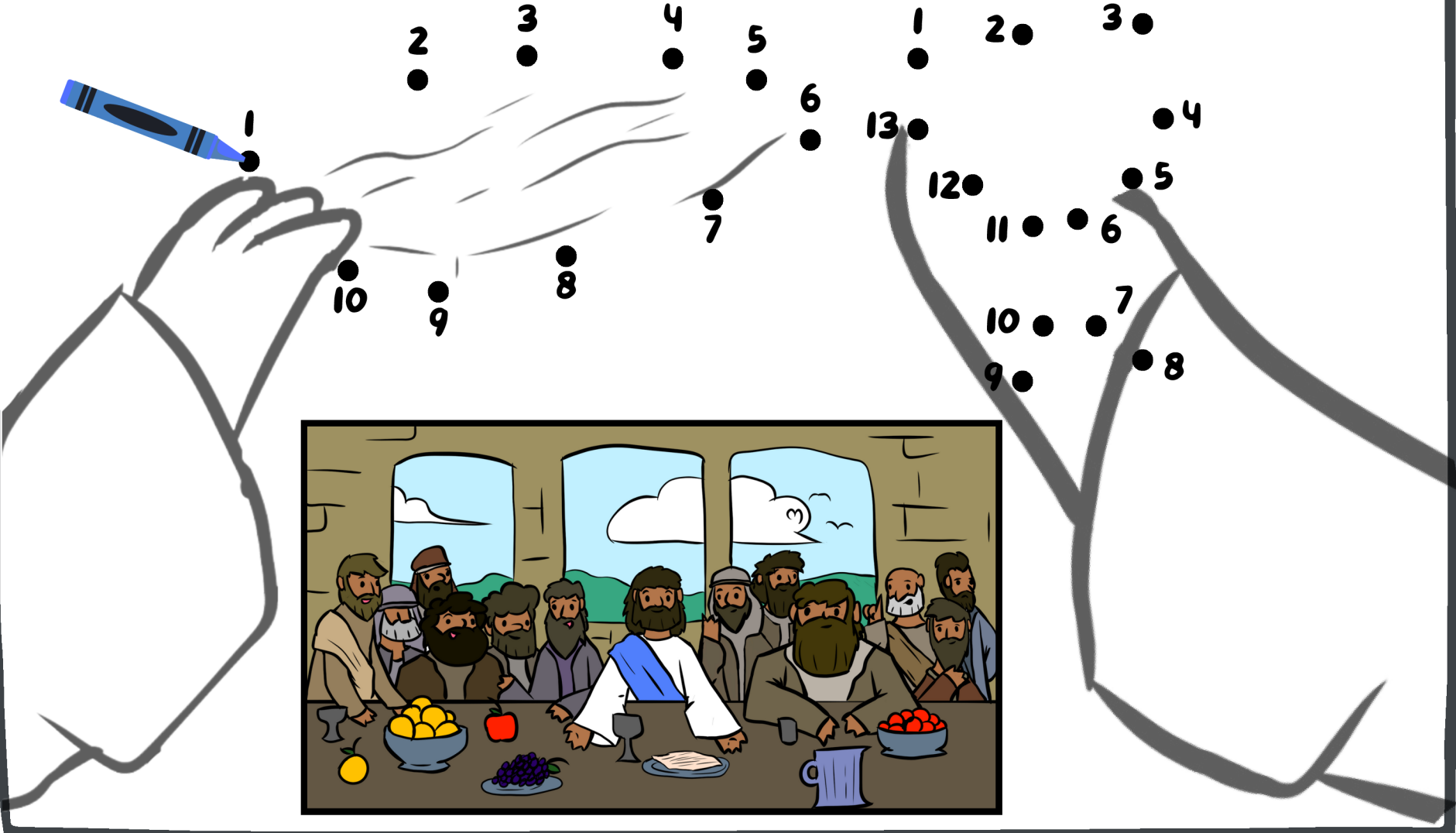
