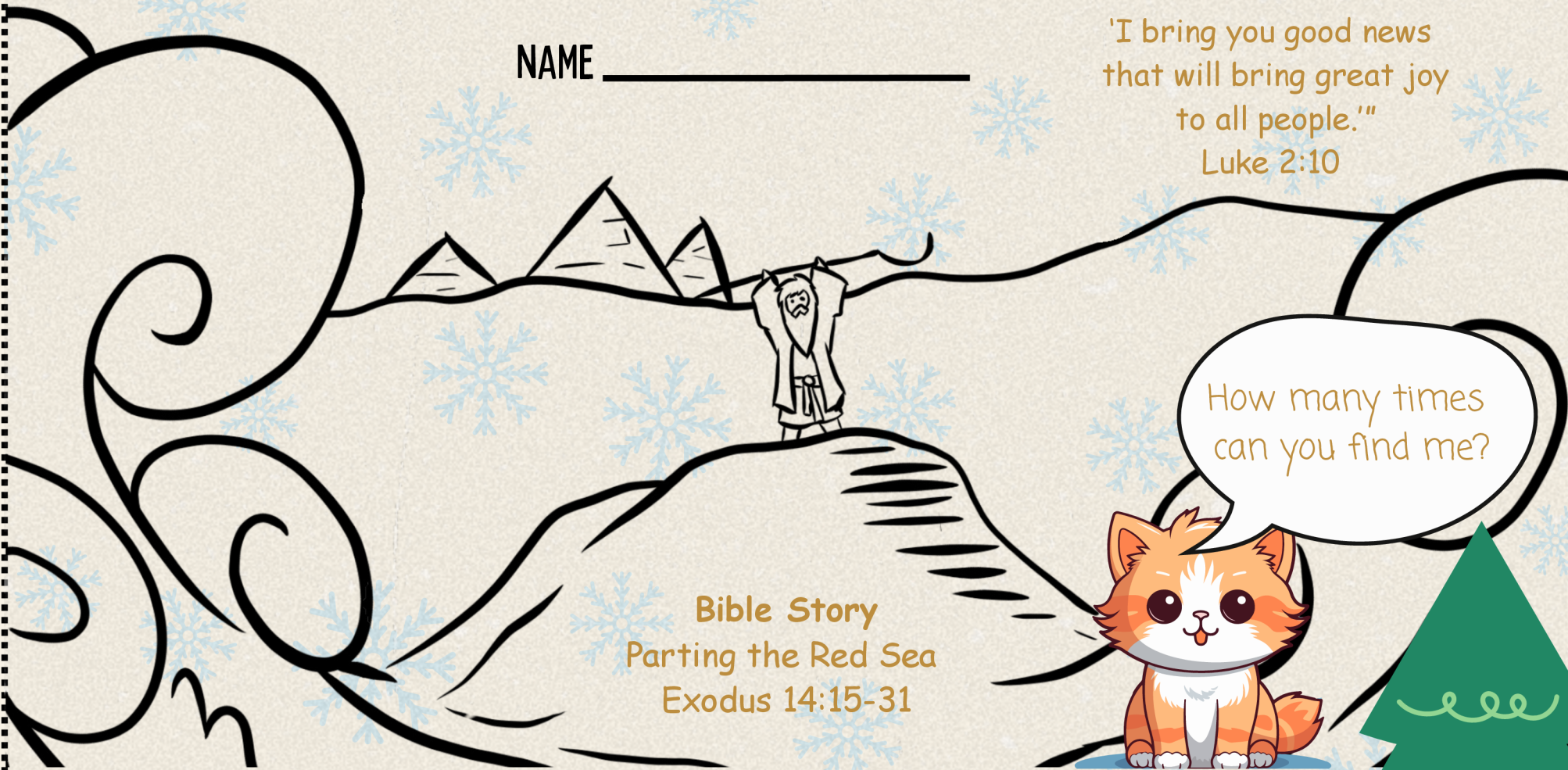
- Why did Chrystal feel like she couldn't help?

And they were being chased by the mean Pharaoh and his army! But God had a plan.

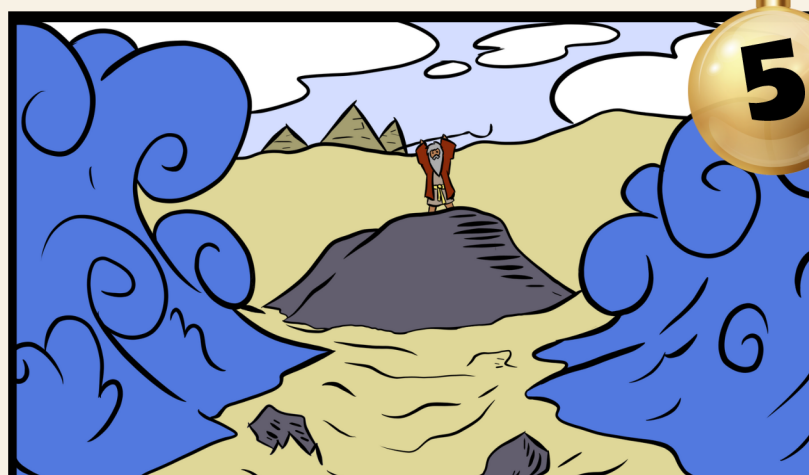

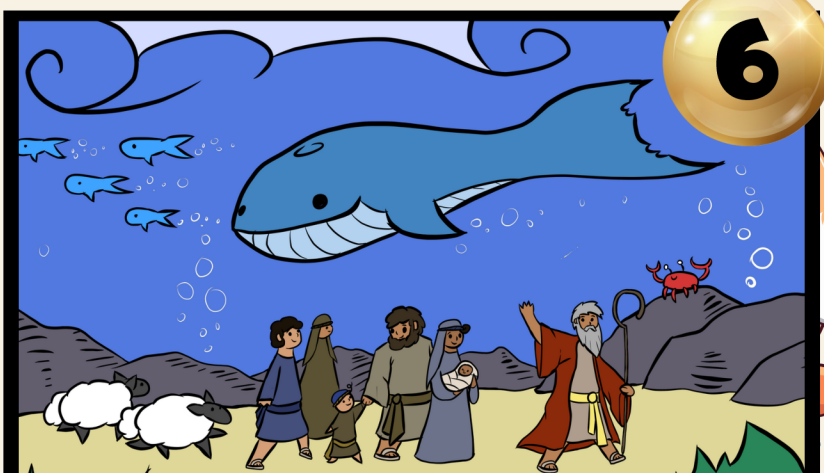

Open your Bible with your child and spend a few minutes reading the scripture and answer the question. Close your time with the special prayer.



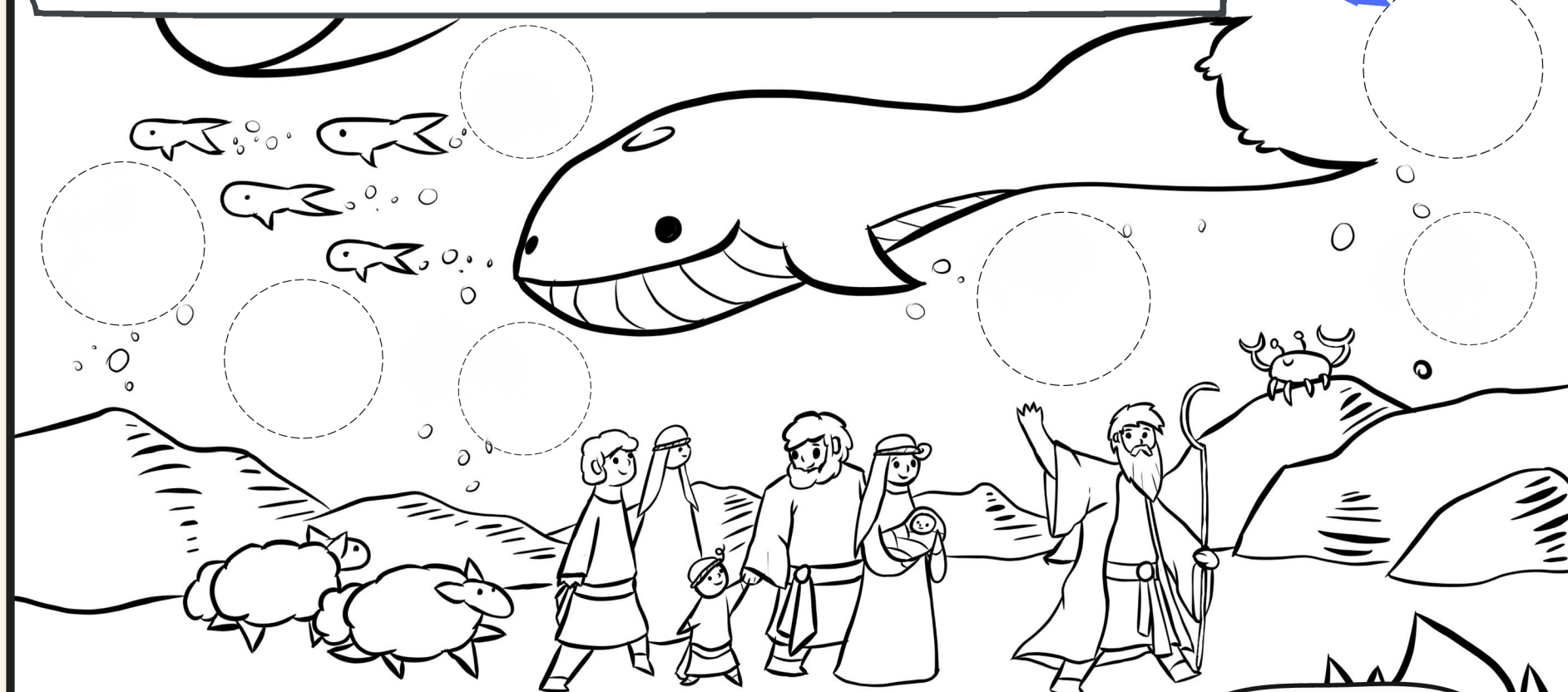
PROVERBS 3:5-6
