1. Wait to know God’s Will.

“Then he asked me, ‘Son of man, can these bones become living people again?’ ‘O Sovereign LORD,’ I replied, ‘you alone know the answer to that.’” Ezekiel 37:3 (p.655)

“May your Kingdom come soon. May your will be done on earth, as it is in heaven.” Matthew 6:10 (p.737)

2. Listen to the Word of the Lord.

“Then he said to me, ‘Speak a prophetic message to these bones and say, ‘Dry bones, listen to the word of the LORD!’” Ezekiel 37:4 (p.655)

“Don’t use foul or abusive language. Let everything you say be good and helpful, so that your words will be an encouragement to those who hear them.” Ephesians 4:29 (p.897)

3. Speak God’s Will.

“So I spoke the message as he commanded me, and breath came into their bodies. They all came to life and stood up on their feet—a great army.” Ezekiel 37:10 (p.655)

“May the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be pleasing to you, O LORD, my rock and my redeemer.” Psalm 19:14 (p.422)
