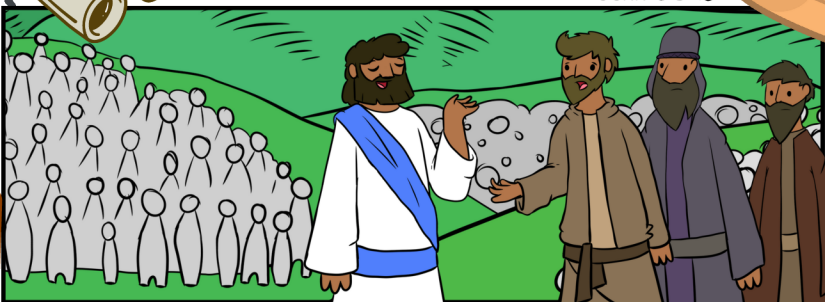


## Fish and Loaves
