

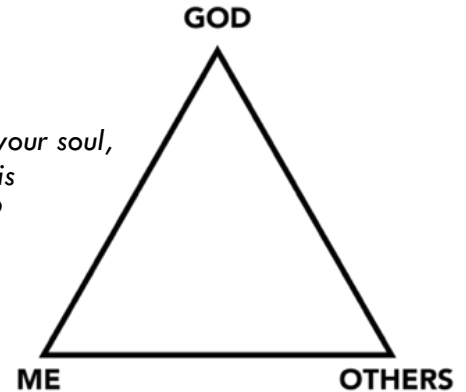
Ten Commandments and The Great Commandment
