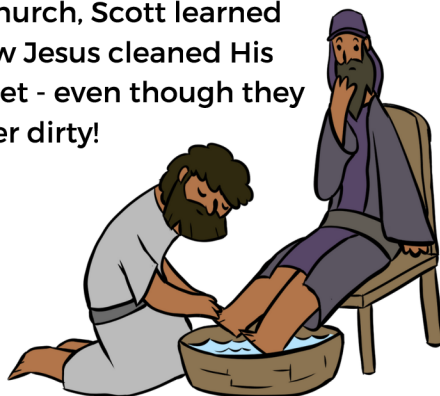


READ SCOTT'S STORY

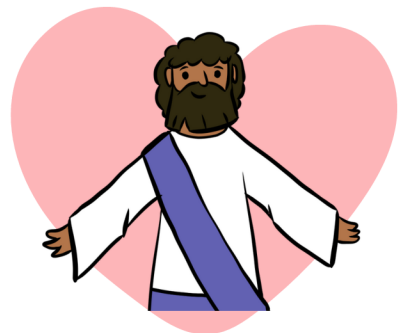
Scott loved to play outside! But his socks and shoes were always so stinky when he got back home. Yucky!

READ JESUS WASHES HIS DISCIPLES' FEET

Did you know that Jesus helped others all the time? He did so many things to show love! Let's learn all about it!

"Jesus ...got up from the table, took off his robe, wrapped a towel around his waist, and poured water into a basin. Then he began to wash the disciples' feet, drying them with the towel he had around him."



"When Jesus came to Simon Peter, Peter said to him, 'Lord, are you going to wash my feet?'"

Jesus replied, 'You don't understand now what I am doing, but someday you will.'



Simon Peter didn't want Jesus to wash his feet - he thought he wasn't good enough!

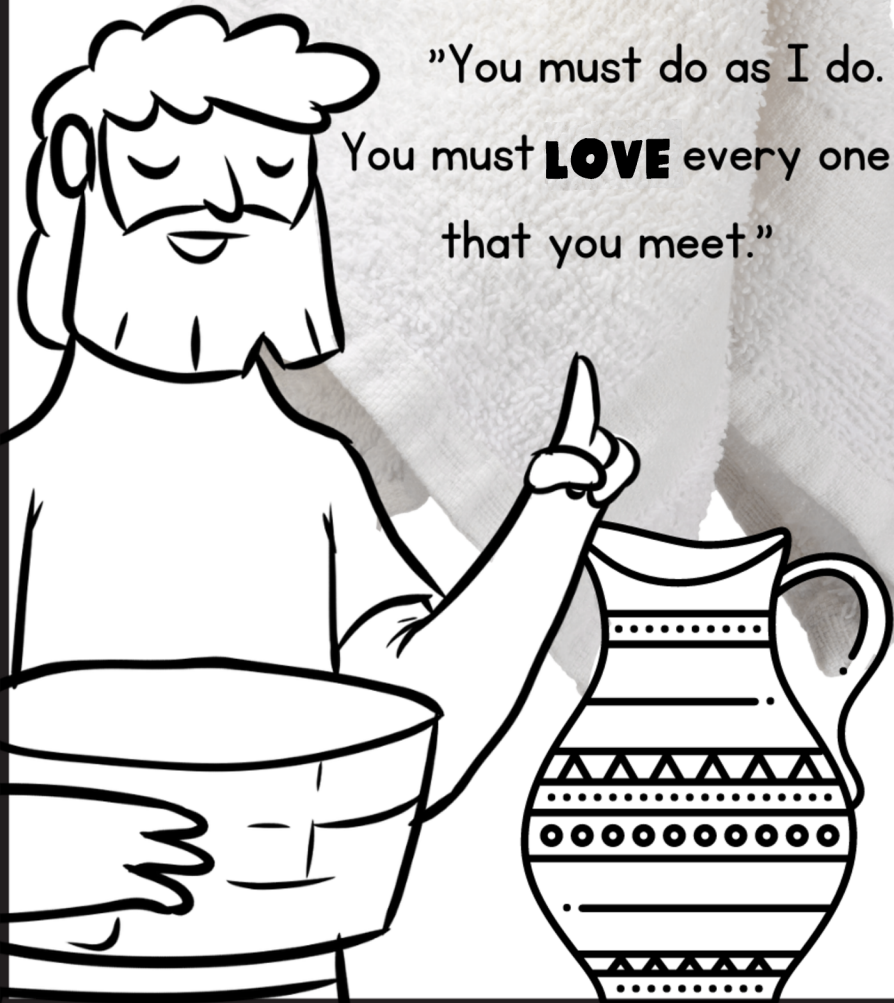
Directions: Look at each picture. What are the kids doing to show love like Jesus? Trace the hearts with a red crayon.

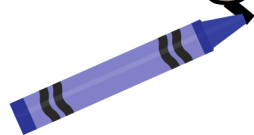
