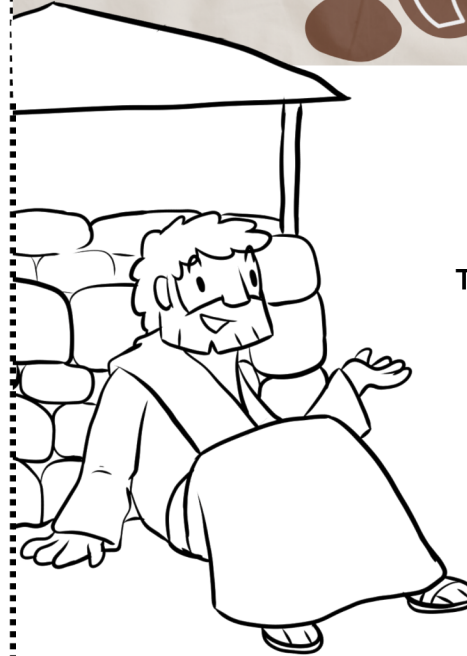

from the well.



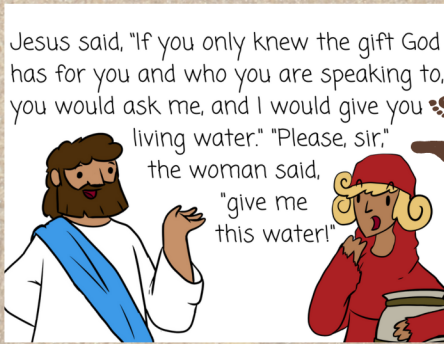
Soon a woman came by and He said,

Why was this man talking to her?



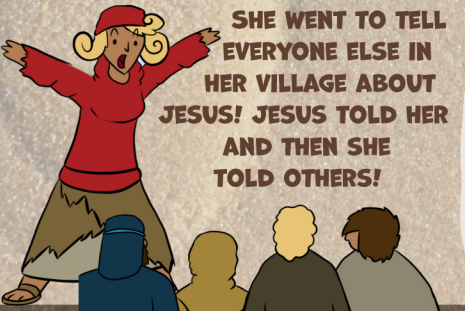
The woman was from

TELLING OUR FRIENDS ABOUT JESUS

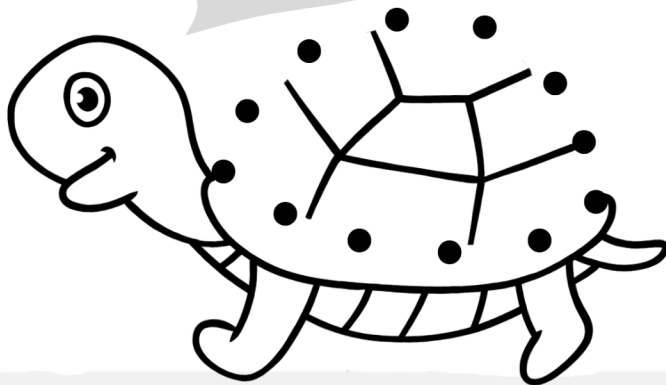
The woman at the well ran and told ALL of the people in her village about Jesus loving and caring for her! Willard is telling Timmy Turtle that Jesus loves and cares for him!

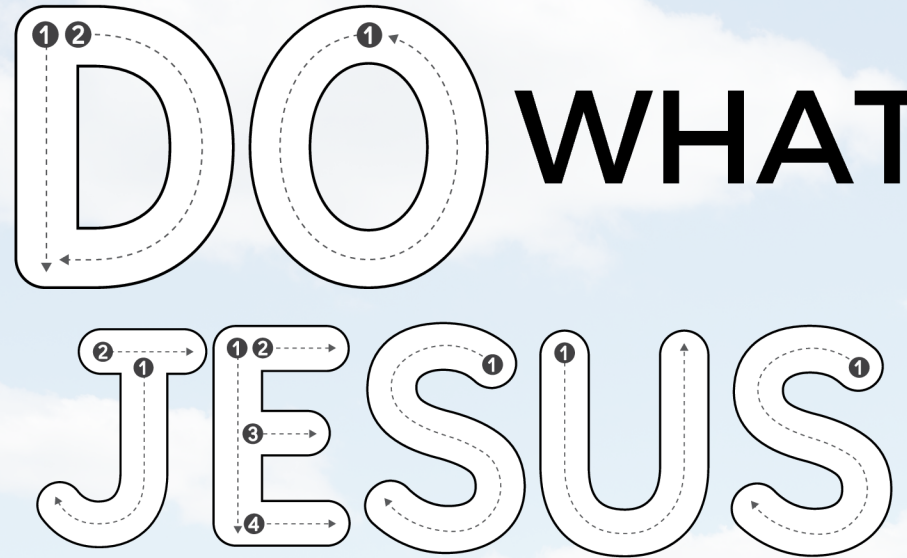
