






READ THE BIBLE STORY

Jesus' body was put in a tomb, but 3 days later, He 2 rose from the dead!



Then Jesus reminded them how, a long time ago, His death and resurrection was talked about!






"Then the two from Emmaus told their story of how Jesus had appeared to them as they were walking along the road, and how they had recognized him...


And He told them that He would send the Holy Spirit to be with us always.
