There is a lot of talk about freedom but there is very little of it. Not so much as that the pressure from outside prevents us from being free, as that many people seem to be simply afraid of it.

Freedom brings many surprises. People like surprises but in general only when the outcome is assured to be positive, but freedom does not guaranty anything, except that all the chances have an equal opportunity.

That is why so many people don't want to see what you paint, but how you paint it.

Our need for choice, selection, decision and judgment comes from the same source which makes the honest soothsayer spell the message out. He doesn't throw the coffee grind in his clients face, telling him to read it himself.
