If you do not wish to explore the LMS or have any issues logging in, below are all of links to view the Childhelp Speak Up Be Safe program, including the **core CH SUBS curriculum for grades PK/K through 12**.

Please note that students themselves do **not** access the program in the LMS – lessons are taught by a facilitator who first take the training and passes a knowledge check quiz. Typically, facilitators include education professionals (school counselor, teacher, resource officer, etc.) or other adult serving youth in the classroom or other group setting, whether live in-person or virtually (for the virtual environment, Childhelp offers a detailed "<u>Teaching Childhelp Lessons Virtually</u>" course with grade-by-grade adaptations for online activities). Thus, there are not various points of view for student vs. teacher vs. administrator.
