Fulfilled in Their Own Time

Zacharias did not believe the words of Gabriel about the fact that he and Elizabeth were to be the parents of the forerunner of the Messiah. Instead of accepting the message from heaven, he thought what God had said just could not happen. How could two old people become parents? The answer from Gabriel gives us insight into the nature of prophecy. The angel said, "Behold, you will be mute and not able to speak until the day these things take place, because you did not believe my words which will be fulfilled in their own time" (Luke 1:20). Look at those closing words—my words will be fulfilled in their own time! This is the nature of prophecy.

Many prophecies specify a time for their fulfillment. Jesus was to be raised on the third day and the words of this prophecy had to come about on that day. Otherwise, Jesus was not God. If what He said did not happen, it was proof that He was a fraud (**Deut. 18:21-22**).

The Old Testament prophesied about the coming of the Messiah and the fact He would come and be a king. The book of Daniel has prophecies about the time this would happen. However, most of Christendom read these prophecies from Daniel and Ezekiel and using human wisdom declare that the kingdom will come at Jesus' second coming. The coming of the Old Testament specified the time it would come. Remember that the words of prophecy

"...will be fulfilled in their own time." What is that time? Listen to Jesus. "The time is fulfilled and the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent and believe in the gospel" (Mark 1:15). Those who teach that the kingdom is future believe they can decide the time of the fulfilment of the words of God. The Messiah looked at those prophecies and said the time for their fulfilment was in the first century.

The time of the Exodus was prophesied over two hundred years before the Jews went into Egypt. This was over 600 years before the Exodus. At age forty, Moses had used human wisdom and decided that the time was fulfilled, and he was to be the one to bring about the exodus. At his birth, "the time of the promise drew near" (Acts 7:17, 20). "Now when he was forty years old...he supposed that his brethren would have understood that God would deliver them by his hand, but they did understand" (Acts 7:23, 25). understood much of the prophecy and his place in the exodus. What he failed to understand was that the determination of the time of fulfillment is not found in human wisdom. He missed it by 40 years.

There is far more to be said about this concept, but when you read His promises, never forget that the fulfilment of prophecy will happen "...in their own time." God does not need our help in deciding when that time is!

We have an amazing God, who sent His amazing Son and then gave us an amazing book! Don't ever take those truths for granted; cherish them and let them motivate you every day. I have something else that I hope you will truly consider, take to heart and keep with you for the rest of your life.

Lock this in your heart: **The Bible is our only authority and has everything we need!** There are all sorts of ideas and philosophies out there about what this life is all about and what our purpose is on this earth, but there is only one source of truth that really matters and to which we need to turn and accept. Knowing that every word in the Bible is inspired of God, notice how He connects the chain of authority.

Truth: Jesus Christ all has authority! Those heard who Jesus recognized that "He taught them as one having authority" (Matt. 7:29), and the reason for that is what He revealed Himself before He left earth, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth" (Matt. 28:18). Jesus Christ is to be heard in all things (cf. Matt. 17:5; Acts 3:22-23).

Truth: All of Jesus Christ's authority is in His Word! While God spoke through prophets in the Old Testament, "God...has... spoken to us by His Son" (**Heb. 1:1-2**). And the Word of Christ is the ultimate authority, for it is the Word given directly by God ("whatever I speak, just as the Father has told Me, so I speak," **John 12:50**) and it is the Word that "will judge [us] in the last day" (**John 12:48**).

Truth: All of Jesus Christ's authority on earth today resides in the inspired words of the Bible! Before Jesus left earth, He told His apostles that the Holy Spirit would "guide [them] into all truth" (John 16:13; 14:25-26), which He did by moving them to pen the words of the New

Testament. Therefore, the very authority of Christ is inherent today within the inspired words of the Bible!

Truth: The Bible is all we need! We have a perfect God! And, when it came time for Him to complete His revelation to mankind in the Bible, He gave us a perfect book! Just as God is lacking in nothing, His Word is lacking in nothing! The reader can be made "complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work" (2 Tim. 3:17), for in them God "has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness" (2 Pet. 1:3). We do not need to go anywhere else to know what God wants us to do; He gave all of His authoritative truth to us in one book!

Truth: We must respond to Christ's authoritative Word with respect and obedience! Only those who do the will of God can be pleasing to Him and go to heaven (Matt. 7:21-27), and the only place to find what is pleasing Him is in His Word (Col. 3:17). Let's respect and obey what He says!
