TO THE WORK

Following up on the workshop, we have some definite actions we must take. Continue and increase works of love (including card-sending, meals, visits and other ways of meeting people's needs). Let's be sure to share who we are serving with each other so that we can begin Bible studies with them. Works of love is the way of "having favor" with the community (Acts 2:47).

Remember the power of the pews. Let's look among ourselves for those attending but are not yet Christians. After establishing friendships with them, let's ask them for a Bible study. "Wouldn't you like to know more about what your Bible says about the church?" Remember the opportunities of relatives. We all have members of our family who need Christ in their lives. Let's be sure to share these names with each other so that we can pray for them and eventually begin a Bible study with them.

We must use house to house/heart to heart in the very best way. House to house has been around Midway for years and we have used it from time to time, but we have never implemented it fully. Take house to house personally to friends and co-workers. Show it to them. Show them the various articles on Bible doctrine, on family helps and on defenses of Christianity. Especially do this – show them the Bible trivia questions, ask them to take and answer these questions and then plan to meet and discuss the answers.

Let's take advantage of all we possess. We have not only house to house issues, but also tracts, bookmarks and Bible study booklets which are excellent in leading someone to the knowledge of the truth. Hopefully, very soon, these will be available in the foyer, but right they can be found in the classroom right off the foyer.

We have plenty of the BACK TO THE BIBLE study booklets available. These booklets help teach about the authority of Christ, the importance of the church and its worship and what must one do to be saved. The booklets have scripture references to read and questions to answer about the verses you read. I have used these with good success over the last several months. --David
