PROTECTION

Though the Bible teaches “the whole world lies in the power of the evil one” (I John 5:19), I am still astounded at the malicious evil we see in our world. Psalm 140 contains some of King David’s remarks about the evil surrounding him.

This Psalm mentions THE WAYS OF THE WICKED.

They “devise evil things in their hearts” (140:2).
They “continually stir up wars” (v.2).
They “sharpen their tongues as a serpent; poison of a viper is under their lips” (v.3).
They are “proud” (v.5), “violent” (v.4), and they “set snares,” and a “hidden trap” (v.5).

This Psalm mentions THE REACTION OF THE RIGHTEOUS.

The righteous affirm their faith – “Thou art my God” (v.6), “the strength of my salvation” (v.7).
The righteous pray specific prayers – “Do not grant, O Lord, the desires of the wicked; do not promote his evil device, lest they be exalted” (v.8). *** This prayer ought to be prayed often and fervently right now!

The righteous continue in the Lord’s work – “I know the Lord will maintain the cause of the afflicted, and justice for the poor. Surely, the righteous will give thanks to Thy name. The upright will dwell in thy presence” (v.12-13).
