Jesus brought a new teaching to the earth. People said, "What is this? A new teaching with authority" (Mark 1:27). The Lord's teaching is perfectly connected to the history of God, placed in language anyone can understand and undergirded by miraculous deeds. "He commands even the unclean spirits and they obey him" (Mark 1:27).

Jesus brought a new covenant to the earth. Through his teaching, his identity as the Son of God and his sacrifice for our sins, Jesus established a "new covenant" with his followers.
