LEARNING ABOUT GOAL-SETTING FROM THE APOSTLE PAUL  
ROMANS 15:20-33

First, base your goals on the mission of Jesus. Jesus came preaching, “repent, for the kingdom of God is at hand” (Matthew 4:17). He came to seek and to save the lost (Luke 19:10) and He also gave the same mission to all of His followers (Mark 16:15,16). In Romans 15, Paul is busy preaching the gospel far and wide, as he puts it, “from Jerusalem to Illyricum” (Rom.15:19). He also has a gift from the brethren in Macedonia and Achaia for the poor saints in Jerusalem, which he intends to deliver. Paul’s plans include: keep preaching at every spot in his travels, deliver the gift to Jerusalem, come to Rome and teach, then, from there, on to Spain (Rom.15:23 -26). A summary of Jesus’ mission is: share the gospel and lift others’ burdens. So, base your goals on these activities and God will be with you (Rom.15:33).

Second, involve others in your goals. Paul had encouraged the brethren of Macedonia and Achaia to help in the gift and “they were pleased to do so” (Rom.15:27). After Paul comes to Rome, he intends to give those brethren the opportunity to help him go on to Spain and preach (Rom.15:24). If a goal is worth having, others need to benefit as well. There is no greater endeavor than the mission of Jesus. Note this remark from the life of Jesus: “And he appointed twelve, that they might be with him, and that he might send them out to preach” (Mark 3:14).

Third, saturate your goals in prayer. How dare we live life (a gift from God, Acts 17:24,25) without seeking guidance from Him. “In Him we live and move and have our very being” (Acts 17:27,28). And, in serving the mission of Jesus, how can we possibly do God’s work without God’s help? “Now I urge you, brethren, by our Lord Jesus Christ and by the love of the Spirit, strive together with me in your prayers to God for me” (Romans 15:30).
