APPOINTMENTS

Appointments, in a sense, control our lives. Doctors, dentists, classes, work, car/house maintenance, family, friends, etc. all occupy thoughts and time.

Please look at the following New Testament appointments, think about them, and allow them to expand in your life.

Jesus was "appointed heir of all things" (Hebrews 1:2). He is the appointed Savior of the world (John 4:42) because of who He is and because of what He has done. He is the One through whom the world was created, He is the radiance of God's glory, He is the exact imprint of God's nature and He upholds the universe through the word of his power (Heb.1:2,3). Jesus made purification for sin and sat down at right hand of the Majesty on high (Heb.1:4). Therefore, God speaks through Jesus and His word today (Heb.1:1-2). He must rule in our hearts (Col.3:15).

"God has not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ" (I Thessalonians 5:9). God did not create us for punishment, but to live for Him. We love Him because He first loved us (I John 4:19). Jesus did not come to condemn the world, but that the world through him might be saved (John 3:17). Forgiveness of sins and a subsequent life of faithful service is our appointment from God. If we will submit to His will, salvation's blessings can be ours (Acts 2:38).

"You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit and that your fruit should abide..." (John 15:16). Part of choosing salvation is the work laid upon us. It is automatic. When we obey Christ, we become servants of righteousness (Rom.6:17,18). In contemplating the power of the gospel, Paul says, "for which I was appointed a preacher and apostle and teacher" (2 Tim.1:11).

"Therefore, brothers, pick out from among you, seven men of good repute, full of the Spirit and wisdom, whom we will appoint to this duty" (Acts 6:3). These are words of the apostles to the brethren in Jerusalem during a time of need for many widows. The task of sharing faith, teaching the word, helping with each other's burdens and encouraging one another is often overwhelming. That's why God wants us to divide the work among us. "It is appointed unto men once to die and after this the Judgement" (Hebrews 9:27). The appointments

mentioned above are to prepare us for the ultimate appointment of death. No one stays on this earth for very long. Let us recognize Jesus as Lord, submit to Him for salvation, and be committed to carrying on His work until the time of our departure.
