STAND IN AWE

"...serve God...with reverence and godly fear" (Heb.12:28).

The right side of the door posts to many Jewish homes bears a little case with the inscription Shaddai (Almighty) which houses two paragraphs from Deuteronomy (6:4-9; 11:13-21). Such reminds the occupants and guests of their responsibility to love and obey God as well as instruction for children. The Jews have a reverence for God (though not according to knowledge, Romans 10:2-3). It is said that the name translated "Jehovah" or "Lord" is so sacred to the Jews that they refer to God as "the One whose name cannot be pronounced."

It is the responsibility of all men to possess and manifest a reverence for the Almighty. "God is greatly to be feared in the assembly of the saints, and to be held in reverence of all them that are about him" (Psalm 89:7).

Three times the word "awe" can be found in the Psalms. A casual scrutiny of these verses provides three reasons why man should revere God. There is the:

Compassion of God (Psalm 4:4).

Creative power of God (Psalm 33:8).

Communication from God (Psalm 119:161).

Webster defines reverence as "a feeling or attitude of deep respect, love, and awe..." Such should flow from every heart toward the august Almighty.

The above inscription is the title of an ongoing Sunday morning telecast. Currently, brother Phil Sanders teaches on the program and does a good job presenting Bible lessons. Many of you remember Mac Lyon hosting this program. Brother Lyon once spoke about his trips to

Russia and the acceptance of the gospel. Government officials told him that the church of Christ has more appeal in Russia than do denominational churches for three reasons: 1) The name emphasizes Christ – the churches of Christ (Rom.16:16). The name should recognize "Jesus is Lord" and bring glory to God (Phil.2:11). 2) The local congregations are autonomous and not ruled by a national or international headquarters. Communists are tired of being under man's authority. Each local church answers only to Christ, its spiritual head (Eph.1:22,23). 3) The Bible is used exclusively as the authority for faith and practice (Col.3:17). Each person can read it for himself. Our commitment for wanting scriptural authority for our practices brings comfort to honest searchers around the world.
