# FORTY-SIX YEARS OF "MURDER" (PART 2)

## Continued From Last Week

Why the talk about murder? For one reason, some try to sidestep the issue of abortion by saying, "How can you stand against abortion while standing for capital punishment?" A little study goes a long way in bringing us to the proper stance on both issues.

But now, back to the point I wanted to make from Genesis 9:6. Do you see the reason murder is prohibited? God said, "...for God made man in his own image." Man is created in the image and likeness of God (Genesis 1:26). He possesses a living soul (Genesis 2:7). He has consciousness and self-awareness, including the ability to know right from wrong. Someone says, "Well a 'fetus' doesn't know right from wrong therefore God must not have prohibited aborting (murdering) one." A six-month old doesn't know the difference between right and wrong—is it alright to murder six-month olds? A four-year old doesn't fully understand right from wrong. Would it be okay just to beat a four-year old "half to death"? The point is not whether one currently possesses the knowledge but the fact

that God made him capable of obtaining it along with all other characteristics of being made in the image of God. When did God give these abilities to the baby. At the same time He gave it a soul—at conception! To take the life of an unborn baby is murder just the same as taking the life of a two-year old, a twenty-two-year old, or a seventy-two-year old.

If society wanted to do what it right, it would not be defending the murderers of the innocent in the womb. Rather, it would be prosecuting them. But, as in many areas, man is determined to have his own way in things. Just pray, and try to convince as many as possible of the error of their ways in these matters. For, Scripture plainly states, "...as for murderers [including the "abortionists, mah]...their portion will be in the lake that burns with fire and sulfur, which is the second death" (Revelation 21:8).

Many suffer because they have been guilty. Remind them that God still loves them and with repentance He forgives.
