# “WHAT IF” QUESTIONS

It is healthy for both our physical and spiritual well-being to practice *possibility thinking*. The question **“What If”** suggests strong possibility or likelihood of some that something could become a reality striking either fear or joy in our hearts. We need to consider the possibilities

**What if** I am still outside the fellowship of God as a non-Christian and never obey the Gospel of Christ? What will happen to me if I die in this condition (2 Thess. 1:8, 9)?

**What if** I profess to be a Christian and do not consider being faithful a very important thing in my life? What will happen to me (Rev. 1:10; 1 Cor. 10:12; Mt. 7:21-27)?

**What if** my children see me doing things that are wrong and not Christlike, yet I tell them to do what is right? Will they grow up to become strong Christians (Eph. 6:4)?

**What if** the elders of the congregation where I am a member begin to practice the

discipline that Christ requires (2 Thess. 3:6; 14, 15)? Would I have to change my attitude and actions lest I myself become a candidate for the possibility of withdrawal of fellowship?

**What if** missing some of the services every week is causing me to become weak and susceptible to the devil's temptations (Heb. 10:23-26)? Could this neglect be dangerous and possibly fatal?

**What if** I continue to not be concerned about others' spiritual welfare and not try to teach them the Gospel of Christ (Mk. 16:15-16)? Will Christ count me as a faithful servant, or will I be rejected on the day of judgment?

**What if** I were arrested on the charge of being a Christian? Would there be enough evidence to convict me?

**What if** I need to change and do not? What then (Jas. 4:17)?

Let us prayerfully consider these matters.
