SOME QUALITIES OF GOOD BIBLE CLASS TEACHERS

Good Bible teachers realize the seriousness of the task before them and that they must answer to God for what they teach (Jas. 3:1; Ezek. 33:17, 18). Those who teach will be judged by the Lord more critically than those who do not teach. If they lead the students in the wrong direction, both the student and the teacher will suffer.

Good Bible teachers realize they must study and prepare to teach their class. Paul exhorted Timothy to study to show himself approved to God (2 Tim. 2:15). Good Bible teachers need to be ready to explain the background and text—make the Bible lesson interesting.

Good Bible teachers realize they must be on time for class. What a terrible example is set before the students when the teacher is tardy. It shows a lack of concern for the most important thing in the world (Matt. 6:33). They should not just arrive on time, teachers should arrive early.

Good Bible teachers realize they must teach the whole counsel of God—all the truth (Acts 20:26-27). They must never hold back any of God's Word for it is all profitable (2 Tim. 3:16-17). We will be judged by it (Jn. 12:48; Rev. 20:12).

Good Bible teachers realize they have a great influence upon those they teach. They have the power to point them in the right or wrong direction. Therefore, they must not only teach the Word, but also live according to the Word (Rom. 2:21-23). It's only natural for the students to look up to their teachers and watch them closely; therefore, teachers must watch all they say and do.

Good Bible teachers are interested in the student's spiritual growth. Many passages exhort us to grow into maturity in the Lord (2 Pet. 3:18; Rom. 10:17; Heb. 5:12-14).

Good Bible teachers realize they need to motivate their students to do their lessons and apply the things learned (2 Cor. 8:11). This comes by being prepared for class and living the lessons every day.

Good Bible teachers realize that Bible study time is not a time to play and party. With most students, such little time is spent in serious Bible study at home, a good teacher will make the most of every minute to instill eternal truths that will make a difference in the student's life (2 Pet. 1:3).
