You have probably heard the voice of your own young one in the pause of "Rock of Ages" sing in an off-key "Jesus Loves Me." You heard in the interlude of announcements a little prayer in the loudest voice—praying for the dog, cat, or some such.

Incidents such as these make one wonder, "Why am I here?" No sooner do you sit down than you get up, reach out, pick up, take out, and on, and on. You want so much to keep your children quiet and not distract others.
