## a note from our

## executive director

My Dear Friends,

So much changed in 2022! It was the year that marked the long-desired reversal of Roe vs Wade by the Supreme Court. We saw our state of Indiana take the lead in passing more restrictive abortion laws, and now await the outcome of court challenges to them. Other states, including our neighbor Michigan, passed more liberal laws or adopted constitutional amendments protecting abortion rights.

We took steps to enhance the security of our staff, clients, and facilities in the face of threats by those angered by the Supreme Court's decision. We dramatically stepped-up spending on Google and other social media advertising to try to fight through all of the noise and falsehoods about what we do and how we do it. It's where we must be in order to reach her.

We contemplated how best to deal with the rapid growth of chemical abortions, which creates an urgency to reach her more quickly than ever before. Do we have the right message to make us her first choice? Do we have the right services to convince her to give us a chance...to give her baby a chance?

Yes, so much changed and yet, mostly nothing changed for our ministry. Unplanned pregnancies will continue to happen regardless of any court rulings, laws, or constitutional amendments. These unplanned pregnancies will still often cause feelings of stress, hopelessness, and despair. And because of these feelings, some women will still see terminating that unplanned pregnancy as their best option.

Without us here, they may see it as their only option.

The other constant in this year of change was you. Despite all the uncertainty, your support never wavered. In fact, 2022 set a new high-water mark for total giving and the total number of donors. My eyes teared up as I wrote this, thinking about the mighty God we serve and how He blessed this ministry so abundantly, once again, through all of you.




Thank you so much for staying with us through this season of change.


