A letter from the student's department may be required. Students who miss an exam or quiz for reasons not involving a University sponsored activity will be allowed to make up one exam and one quiz. The coordinator neither needs nor wants to hear the reason for the absence, so don't bother telling him. While the grade may be made up, the absence will not be removed from the student's record and counts toward the 4 absences precipitating an automatic F. Make ups should be arranged with the TA.
